- To create squares 12" x 12" using wool, silk & cotton.
- To leave a 1" border around any design/motif etc you may have created on the square (for later stitching together purpose). This gives a 10" design space.
- To put information on Facebook, but only for the purpose of those involved in the Wool, Silk & Cotton project.
- Anne Linehan to put information on Calderdale Interfaith website.
- Cllr Ann Kirkstone will speak to the Council about the possibility of putting information on their website.
- To use different venues that have been offered for meeting up as King Cross library is a bit noisy.
- To try to finish the project by February 2025.
- All costs will be reimbursed. Please keep all receipts.
- Please take photos where you can of your group working together. I have to supply evidence.
- We will choose a colour at the end to bind all these squares together, green is a favourite so far.
- Finally we will try and get the town hall in Halifax for the final stitching.

As we are very close now to the summer holidays I will not organise another meeting until September.

However, I am available at any time to chat, reimburse spending, attend one of your sessions or anything else I can help with.
